Chris Lowney, a one-time Jesuit seminarian, later served as a Managing Director of JP Morgan & Co on three continents until leaving the firm in 2001. He currently chairs the Board of Catholic Health Initiatives, one of the largest healthcare systems in the United States, comprised of more than 100 hospitals. He has authored five books, including the just-published *Everyone Leads: How to Revitalize the Catholic Church*. He has also authored the bestselling *Heroic Leadership*, which has been translated into a dozen languages; and *Pope Francis: Why he Leads the Way He Leads*. He is a graduate of Fordham University, was raised in Queens, NY, hates the Yankees and roots for the Mets without feeling shame.
