



### Standard #14 Moral Conscience

Develop a moral conscience informed by Church teachings.

#### Performance Indicators

- ~Point out that we have a choice to do good.
- ~Explain that we sin when we choose not to do good.

Assessment : How will you know that the children learned or are able to perform the indicators?

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#### Some Sample Activities



Create mini diaries for the children and ask them to keep track of all the good deeds they do for one week .



Allow time for the children to talk about what conscience means and how they learn right from wrong.



Read aloud the Bible story of Moses receiving the Ten Commandments at Mt. Sinai. Discuss how the commandments help us make good choices.



Ask the children to draw a picture of how they feel when they choose not to do good.



Help the children memorize Jesus' Law of Love. Encourage them to recite it for their parents and share how the family can practice it at home.



Allow time for the children to tell stories about some of the choices they have made, identifying which were good and which were not. Encourage them to talk about the how the good choices were consistent with Christian values.
