





After the Gospel reading, the local Church requests the Bishop to ordain the candidates.

The deacon assigned to do this responds to the Bishop's questions by informing him in the presence of the people that there are no doubts concerning the candidates.

The Bishop responds: "Relying on the help of the Lord God and our Savior Jesus Christ, we choose these, our brothers, for the Order of the Diaconate."

The people then give their assent to this decision by the response"

"Thanks be to God"

followed by applause.


PROMISE OF THE ELECT

The candidates stand before the Bishop and all the faithful and express their resolve to carry out their office in accord with the mind of the Christ and the Church, under the direction of the Bishop.

LITANY OF SUPPLICATION

In the litary all present plead for God's grace for the candidates. As a sign of humility, the candidates prostrates themselves.

All others are invited to kneel.



ORDINATION OF DEACONS

LAYING ON OF HANDS AND PRAYER OF ORDINATION TO THE DIACONATE

Through the laying on of hands by the Bishop and the Prayer of Ordination, the gift of the Holy Spirit for the office of deacon is conferred on the candidates.

The following words belong to the nature of the rite and are consequently required for the validity of the act:

"Send forth upon them, Lord, we pray the Holy Spirit, that they may be strengthened by the gift of your sevenfold grace for the faithful carrying out of the work of the ministry."

VESTING WITH THE STOLE AND DALMATIC

Immediately after the Prayer of Ordination, the newly ordained Deacons are invested with diaconal stoles and dalmatics. By this investiture the liturgical ministry that they will henceforth fulfill is outwardly manifested.

HANDING ON OF THE BOOK OF THE GOSPELS


The handing on of the Book of Gospels signifies the office of the deacon to proclaim the Gospel in liturgical celebrations and to preach the faith of the Church in word and deed.

FRATERNAL KISS

The Bishop and representatives from the Deacons offer a fraternal kiss of peace to the newly ordained as a sign of welcome into the Order of Deacons.

PREPARATION OF THE ALTAR AND GIFTS See Us, Lord, About Your Altar






