At Faith House, up to four women live in a home-like setting, under the daily care of a husband-wife team of house parents. Women receive counseling around their plans to parent or place their child for adoption. Mothers can live in the home through their children's first birthday. A staff caseworker will assess practical needs, helping with public health benefits, prenatal care. A combination of community partnerships and staff-led classes, women at Faith House will receive training in job skills, financial management, and skills necessary to obtain, run and sustain a home. An in-home Earn While You Learn program will educate on pregnancy and parenting, earning Baby Bucks for the maternity shop.
