Safe Environment Corner: Did You Know...about 100 kids per year are abducted by strangers. This equates to fewer than 1% of abductions. Yet media stories can hyperfocus on abductions by strangers, generating fear of these statistically rare instances. Reports show that most children are taken by people they know somehow, which is true of almost all forms of child victimization (including sexual abuse).
