PRIORITY ONE:

Strengthening Faith Formation in Family Life

- Goal 1: Establish Youth Ministry, in accordance with diocesan standards, in 25-30 parishes with competent, qualified leaders (adults and youth) by June 30, 2015.
- Provide Family Catechesis for the Seven Sacraments for every parish by Goal 2: February 1, 2016

PRIORITY THREE:

Building Parishes with Living Stones

- Goal 1: Charter a diocesan Living Stones Planning Committee with a clear mission and broad representation by September 1, 2014.
- Goal 2: Complete diocesan-wide Find Your Home in Christ Census of all households between October 1, 2014 and August 1, 2015.
