ABORTION PILL REVERSAL

The Abortion Pill Rescue helpline 1-877-558-0333 works with a network of over 500 doctors ready and willing to help a woman who regrets taking the abortion pill. The success rate is 68% if started within 72 hours of taking the pill. 500 babies have been born healthy after abortion pill reversal.

FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS

Health Centers care for you, even if you have no health insurance. They provide services that include checkups when you are well, treatment when you are sick, complete care when you are pregnant, and immunizations and checkups for your children. Some health centers also provide mental health, substance abuse, oral health, and vision services. Contact the health center directly to confirm services and make an appointment.
